Mississippi State's Nick Fitzgerald grew up a Georgia fan, but that won't matter Saturday

STARKVILLE — When Nick Fitzgerald was in elementary school, he had an area rug at the foot of his bed in his room. The rug's colors: red, black and white. There was a large "G" in the middle of it.

The curtains in Fitzgerald's room were the same color pattern and featured various logos for the UGA Bulldogs. Georgia football posters decorated the walls, including one of his uncle Charles Pledger, who played cornerback for Georgia from 1990-93.

His family settled down just outside Savannah, Georgia when he was about 8 years old. That was right around the time Fitzgerald went to his first Georgia football game. Fitzgerald once got an autographed picture with former Georgia quarterback Matthew Stafford, and even attended former longtime Georgia coach Mark Richt's two-day camp when he was 8 or 9.

"He was a Dawg forever," his father Derrick said. "Georgia was his thing."

Fitzgerald tried to land a Georgia scholarship in high school and never received one, but his dream of playing in Athens will come true Saturday — in a twist, he'll just be in a Mississippi State uniform.

This is #17 Mississippi State (3-0) at #11 Georgia (3-0) in primetime (6 PM Central, ESPN). The winner earns the right to be called the second-best team in the SEC behind #1 Alabama.

For Fitzgerald, this is an opportunity to build off his best game of the young season and, against a defense widely-regarded as one of the nation's finest, further legitimize the idea that he is the SEC's top quarterback.

"When it came time to get recruited, I went to every Georgia camp I could and it would've been awesome and I would've loved it," Fitzgerald said. "They just didn't want me."






